This smolders beautifully already, with charcoal, bay and tobacco notes wafting up from the core of mulled currant, fig and blackberry fruit. The long finish lets a ganache accent course through, revealing a tarry underpinning. Best from 2017 through 2028. *From France.—J.M.*

Ermitage White Le Reverdy 2012 93 points | \$119 | 9 cases imported | White

Ripe and open, with bold apricot, nectarine and creamed tangerine notes, laced with ginger and graham cracker hints and carrying through a toasted almond-edged finish. Broad and flattering in feel, but with enough buried zip to stay honest. Drink now through 2019.—*J.M.*

Hermitage Les Miaux 2012

93 points | \$95 | 22 cases imported | Red

Very solid, with ample range to the bay, olive and tar notes that line the dark currant– and plum-filled core, while tobacco and singed alder details line the finish. Shows lots of brambly grip, with a peppery echo. Let this settle in the cellar. Best from 2017 through 2024.—J.M.

### **FERRATON PÈRE & FILS**

Ermitage Les Dionnières 2012 94 points | \$119 | 15 cases imported | Red

Dark and dense, with a terrific core of black currant, fig and black-berry paste flavors, shrouded for now by roasted tobacco, chest-nut, bay and tapenade notes. Shows loads of burly grip through the finish, but the flesh is there. Cellar for maximum effect. Best from 2018 through 2028.—*J.M.*

Côte-Rôtie Lieu-Dit Montmain 2012 94 points | \$99 | 12 cases imported | Red

Gorgeous, with racy plum, cassis and bitter cherry fruit seamlessly layered with a mouthwatering iron note. Long and pure through the finish, showing flecks of savory, bay and white pepper as the fruit pumps through. Best from 2017 through 2028.—*J.M.* 

### **FERRATON PÈRE & FILS**

Côte-Rôtie L'Eglantine 2012 93 points | \$79 | 10 cases imported | Red

This has nice chalky cut, featuring a core of bright damson plum, violet and savory notes. Very racy through the finish, with the fruit laced by a singed alder accent. Best from 2017 through 2027.—*J.M.*
